

Department of Crop Farming, Agrochemistry and Soil Science

The Crop Farming Department was established in 1934 and comprised courses in General Agriculture, Soil Science, Geology, Agricultural Reclamation and Feed Production.

The first head of the department was associate professor Petikov O. I.

Doctor of Agricultural Science, a graduate student of the Agronomy Faculty in the past, I. D. Prymak has managed the department since September 1993.

For many years the department scientists have taught basic disciplines that create real agricultural experts. Educational and methodological support is an important duty of the department scientific and teaching staff. The research results are presented in many textbooks, reference books and monographs.

The department staff now consists of 14 people: Chairperson – Doctor of Agricultural Sciences, Professor I. D. Prymak; Professors, Doctors of Agricultural Sciences – L. M. Karpuk and S. P. Vahniy; Candidates of Agricultural Sciences – N. V. Lozinskyi, A. V. Krykunova, M. V. Voytovyk, S. V. Obrazhiy, R. M. Kulyk; assistants – A. A. Pavlichenko, A. B. Panchenko; laboratory assistants – T. V. Kolesnyk, G. L. Ustynova, T. H. Myalkovska, M. U. Novohatska.

The department offers the following disciplines: Agriculture, Agricultural Reclamation, Agrometeorology, Herbology, Agrochemistry, Fertilizer Use, Soil Science with the basics of Geology, Forestry, Soil Science, Soil Science with the fundamentals of Agrochemistry, Geology and Geomorphology, Soil Science, World and Ukraine Soils, Adaptive Farming Systems, Environmental Problems of Agriculture, Research in Agronomy: methods and organization .

The department scientists provide own experimental studies on the experimental field of Bila Tserkva NAU according to research direction: "Energy-saving technologies of mechanical tillage and rational crop rotation development for the Central Forest Steppe of Ukraine".

During the last five years the department staff has published more than 100 scientific articles in professional journals, 3 books, 13 manuals, 2 doctoral and 2 PhD dissertations.
