The department of Management trains highly qualified specialists in the fields of "Management" and "Public Management and Administration" in business running aimed at sustainable development of both an organization and the economy as a whole.

Training in management specialists is carried out in the following educational levels:

Bachelor (6.030601 "Management"),

Specialist (specialty 7.03060101 "Enterprise Management and Administration")

Master (specialty 8.03060101 "Enterprise Management and administration").

The department staff comprises an Academician of NAAS, 7 teachers with PhD in Economics Scs as well as a PhD in Agriculture and Pedagogical Sciences and 3 assistant lectures. The Department is training 4 PhD students.
