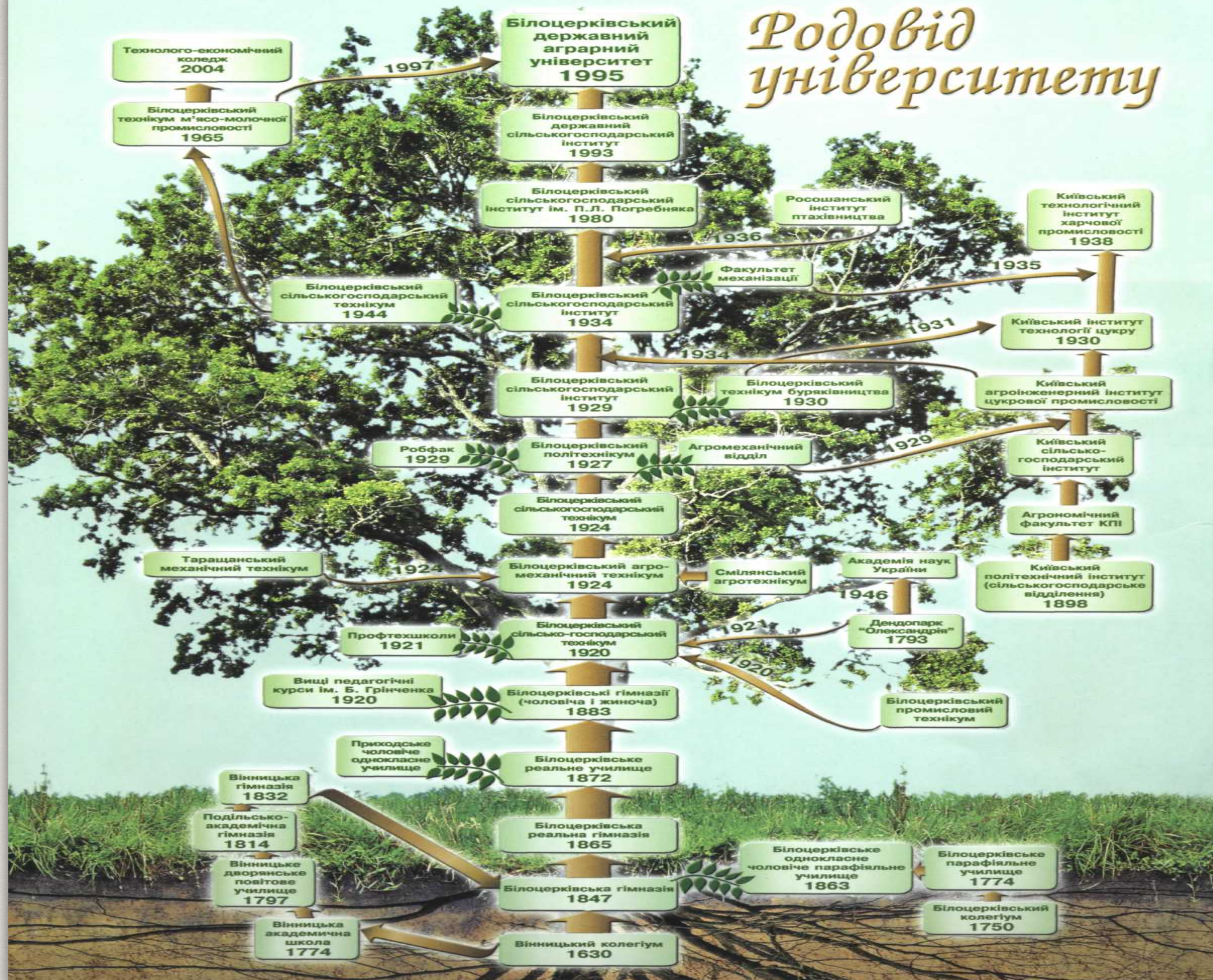

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- ❖ Bila Tserkva University consists of 6 faculties, which provide the education on 16 bachelor, 18 master and 8 PhD study programs
- ❖ the education is provided by 371 teachers, 260 of them are PhD, 54 – doctors of sciences

# Bio-Bio Project: Indicators of biodiversity in organic and low-input farming systems

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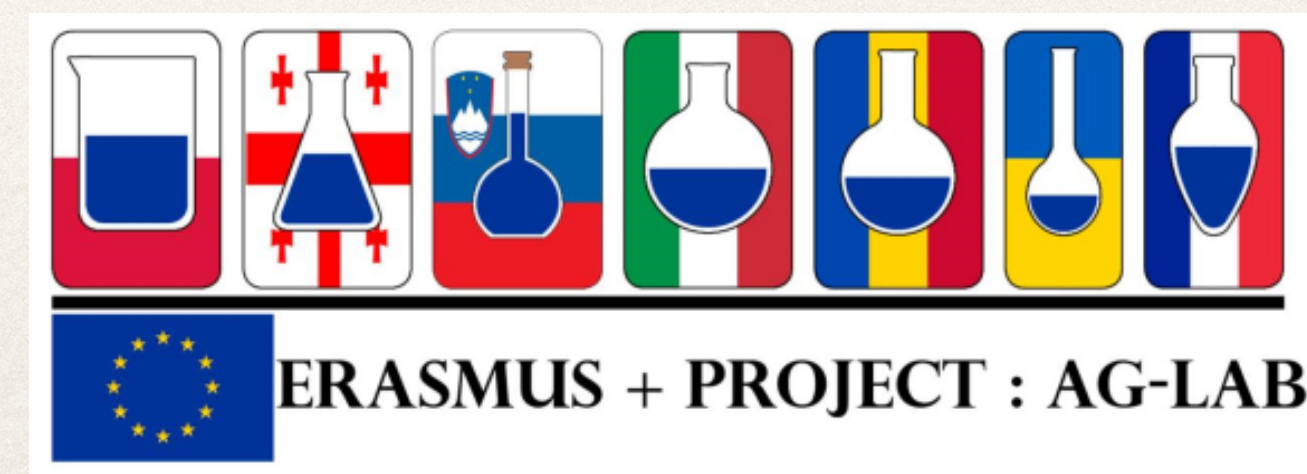
