КРИТЕРІЇ ОЦІНЮВАННЯ

Тестові завдання для вступу на навчання за освітньою програмою «Германські мови та літератури (переклад включно), перша - англійська» першого (бакалаврського) рівня вищої освіти складаються з 10 варіантів по 25 запитань із комплексу фахових дисциплін. Запитання потребують вибору однієї або кількох відповідей із запропонованого набору варіантів, вибору відповідності або їхньої послідовності.

Оцінювання результатів вступних випробувань здійснюється за шкалою від 100 до 200 балів. Мінімальна кількість (100 балів) нараховується, якщо 50% відповідей на тестове завдання є правильними. За правильне вирішення питання, що містить лише одну правильну відповідь, або всі правильні відповіді запитання з множинним вибором (кілька правильних відповідей) вступник отримує 8 балів. Якщо запитання має множинний вибір і вступник надав правильну відповідь на більше, ніж 50, але менше, ніж 100 відсотків, то за таке питання він отримує 4 бали. Відсутність відповіді, неправильна відповідь або менше 50% правильних відповідей у запитаннях множинного вибору оцінюється в 0 балів. Час виконання тестових завдань становить 60 хвилин.

12. Describe your favourite room to a partner and say what you do there.
13. Imagine you have a chance to go abroad for studying. What country would you chose and why?
14. Where would you like to live in future - in your native country or abroad? What do you like best about living in Ukraine? What would you miss if you lived abroad?
15. Do you like watching films? What is your favorite genre? Tell your impressions from the last seen film.
16. Do you like reading books? What is your favorite genre? Tell your impressions from the last read book
17. Describe the best shopping centre in your city/town.
18. Do you have any plans for the future? How do you see your professional and personal life in 5 or 10 years? What should you do to make all your dreams come true?
19. Summer vacations are coming. Tell about your plans for the summer specifying as many details as possible.
20. Think about the teenage years which can be difficult for both children and parents. Why, do you think? What can go wrong? Share your own experience.
21. Tell what types of problems are typical in the relationships between children and parents. Is it possible to avoid them? Give your own solutions to each group of these problems.
22. Can the TV and computers substitute reading books.
23. Imagine you are going to London. Tell your friends the most important facts

about this city and what sights you would like to visit there.

24. Have you ever been abroad? Tell about your experience or about the country you would like to visit in the future.
